








House of Representatives




Illinois Senate






Process Overview




Repeated in both chambers

HB 2739: Private Primary Residential Flood Insurance Act


Synopsis: Requires insurers to notify Department of Insurance at least 30 days before selling flood insurance in the State.

Example Bill

HB 2739: Private Primary Residential Flood Insurance Act

Filing a Witness Slip

ILGA Dashboard

A witness slip is a person's or group's position on a particular bill

File as soon as the committee hearing is posted

A new witness slip is required for each committee hearing posted

Witness slips can be submitted for amendments filed that are being heard in committee

Relationships are Important

Why should you build relationships with elected officials?

AWARENESS:

Elected officials can help you to spread awareness of your interests, work and your organization's mission.

RELATIONSHIPS:

Elected officials were elected by having strong networks.

PROBLEM SOLVING:

You might have a problem one day that they can help you with.

ACCESS:

You will become a trusted source of information for decision-makers.

FUNDING:

Elected officials can be a resource in pointing you to potential funding sources.


