 - Community Rating for FP Mgmt Efforts
- Flood Insurance Discounts based on Classification
- Recognition as a Floodplain Mgmt.
 Leader
 - Provides Ideas to "Get Better"

How To Join?


- Be in Regular Phase of the NFIP for at least 1 year

- Find \geq 500 points
- Request FEMA Compliance Review
 (CAV)
- Schedule Application Mtg.
- Prepare Documentation


