






Build safely and solidly

What's Your Risk

- Water does not read maps and obey a line of a map.
- Flood risk is everywhere
- Your home is three times more likely to flood than burn over 30 years – buy flood insurance

MT-1 Community Acknowledgement

- Based on review, we find:
 - Meets all fpm requirements with no floodway fill
 - All Federal, State, and local permits obtained
 - Reasonably safe from flooding 44CFR 65.2(c)
 - All documentation on file and available
 - LOMR-F and CLOMR-F meets Sections 9 & 10 of Endangered Species Act (no harm and permit)

NFIP Insurance Points to Remember

- NFIP Reauthorized until March 28
- Between December 2008 and December
 2009, IL policies in force declined 1309 total
- Everyone is at risk. Insurance is your safeguard day in, day out, disaster declaration or not, whatever zone
- Effective floodplain management is living with risk, not denying your risk! Plan to live safely.
